

## Conditional Order - Example

### Down Trigger

- Buy/Sell
- Trigger price must be **less than market price** , the limit price may be higher or lower than trigger price

Eg: You bought a long position at 17100, you would like to cut loss at 17090 in case the market goes down

- Input 17090 for trigger price , when market reaches 17090, order will be sent to market
- Limit price is set at 17085 , meaning when the condition of 17090 is triggered, the limit order of 5 points price trailing will be sent to market
