Haitong International Successfully Completed an IPO deal for China Hengshi

Hong Kong, 22 December 2015 – Haitong International Securities Group Limited (“Haitong International”; Stock Code: 665.HK) is pleased to announce that it has completed an IPO deal for China Hengshi Foundation Company Ltd. (“China Hengshi”, 1197.HK) with gross proceeds of around HKD 540 million. Haitong International acted as the Joint Bookrunner and Joint Lead Manager to assist the company in the IPO deal and successfully raising funding from the equity market.

China Hengshi is a leading global manufacturer and supplier of fiberglass fabrics used in wind turbine blades.

Haitong International has already completed 14 IPO deals so far this year.
